EmergyCare is hiring a full and part-time hourly non-exempt EMR/Ambulance Driver.

The EMR/Ambulance Driver will provide transportation for wheelchairs, medical taxis, and stretcher transports for patients to hospitals, nursing homes, doctor offices, or any other facility previously approved. The Emergency Medical Responder/Ambulance Driver (EMR) works closely with the EMT to provide effective and efficient patient care per established protocols relevant to EMR certification.

Must obtain Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) certification within one year of the date of hire and maintain current EMT certification thereafter. The EMR is fully responsible for all actions as a certified EMR and is accountable for the quality of emergency and non-emergency medical care delivered. In delivering pre-hospital emergency care, the EMR performs all basic life support techniques, provides specified field treatment for medical emergencies, and transports patients to the appropriate medical facility. This includes ambulances, wheelchairs, and medical vans.

Must maintain Emergency Medical Services Vehicle Operator (EMSVO) credentials.

The Wheelchair Transporter is required to obtain his/her Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) Certification within one (1) year of hire date and maintain it going forward.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Qualified candidates High school diploma or general education degree (GED)
- Must have a valid driver's license and excellent driving record.
- Emergency Medical Technician (EMR) certification required One (1) year of hire date.
- Current driver's licenses, certified as an Emergency Medical Responder by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, hold a current CPR certification approved by the Department of Health.
- Candidates must be at least 18 years of age or older due to regulations set forth by the PA Public Utilities Commission (PUC).
- Must be able drive 5 to 8 hrs. per shift.

Qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability or protected veteran status.
